Luxembourg Presidency

••• Welcome Note

Luxembourg will take over the Presidency of the European Union along the first semester of 2005. The challenge is significant. Although the exercise is well known to a founding State, it always surfaces within a particular context. In 2004 the Union went through an unprecedented enlargement, from 15 to 25 members. Bulgaria and Romania will shortly sign their Accession Treaty, while Turkey and Croatia enjoy a status as candidate countries. Switzerland for its part negotiated its entry into the Schengen area. 2004 was also marked by European elections and the installation of a new European Parliament and a new Commission. And finally, 2004 will enter History as the year when the Treaty establishing a Constitution for Europe was signed. This is not a mere passage from one treaty to another, but represents on the contrary a significant progress in the European construction, and in particular in the setting up of an area of freedom, security and justice.

In the field of justice and home affairs, 2004 saw the achievement of the programme adopted by the European Council in Tampere in 1999. The Hague Programme, approved by the European Council on 5 November 2004, carries on the task. It defines clear political objectives aimed at strengthening freedom, security and justice. While keeping with the direction indicated by Tampere, The Hague Programme takes into account new threats, allows for the consolidation and development of the normative framework, and puts the accent on operational European cooperation.

Luxembourg welcomes the fact that the Constitutional Treaty served as a reference for the determination of the level of ambition of The Hague Programme. It is now up to the Luxembourg Presidency to launch this multi-annual programme and to prepare its implementation together with all of its European partners in the great European project.

It is in this very spirit that we have the pleasure to invite you to Luxembourg from 27 to 29 January 2005, just a few weeks after The Hague Programme has been approved. Our informal meeting should allow us to go through a first exchange of views between Interior and Justice Ministers in order to initiate the implementation of our new programme. By confirming our level of ambition, our debates should give orientations to the Commission in view of the elaboration of the 2005-2010 action plan.

We are thus proposing to structure our discussions along those key notions underlined by The Hague Programme, and to begin the meeting on 28 January by reflecting on possible European policies with regard to the cross-border recognition and enforcement of criminal sentences in view of “strengthening justice”. At lunchtime we will broach the question of financial perspectives in relation with the JHA, followed by an afternoon discussion on operational police and judicial cooperation in view of “strengthening security” at the European level.

We will resume on 29 January by identifying orientations and priorities which ought to guide the drafting of the action plan intended to implement The Hague Programme. We will finally close our meeting by addressing the issue of “strengthening freedom” with a discussion on the external dimension of asylum policies.

We are delighted to welcome you in Luxembourg and wish you a pleasant stay in a peaceful and wintry setting.

1. The press centre

The Informal Meeting of Justice and Home Affairs Ministers takes place at the Kiem Conference Centre.

It is located on the Kirchberg, in the north-east of Luxembourg City and can hold 1 700 persons.

The press centre is situated in the halls 3 and 4 of the Kiem Conference Centre.

The press centre offers 400 working spaces, one press conference room with cabins for translators, 30 briefing rooms, 50 posts with cutting/recording/taping tools and five stand-up positions.

Catering is available in the new press lounge, a convivial space exclusively reserved for journalists.

In December 2004, it was awarded the Luxembourg Architecture Price 2004 of the *Fondation de l'architecture et de l'ingénierie*.

8. TV and radio

Broadcasting Centre Europe (BCE) is the host broadcaster of the Luxembourg Presidency of the Council of the European Union and provides technical services for TV and radio, production and distribution of pool signals.

In collaboration with the EBU (European Broadcasting Union), the host broadcaster provides multi- and unilateral transmissions.

EBU is responsible for the reservations of editing rooms, stand up positions and the feed.

Television/Radio editing rooms are situated in the halls 3 and 4 of the press centre. They are equipped with an analogue telephone line, ISDN line, television sets and are able to receive the television signal of the host broadcaster.

You will also find injection points for the EBU, SNG connections, 2 equipped stand up positions as well as 2 editing rooms with editors.

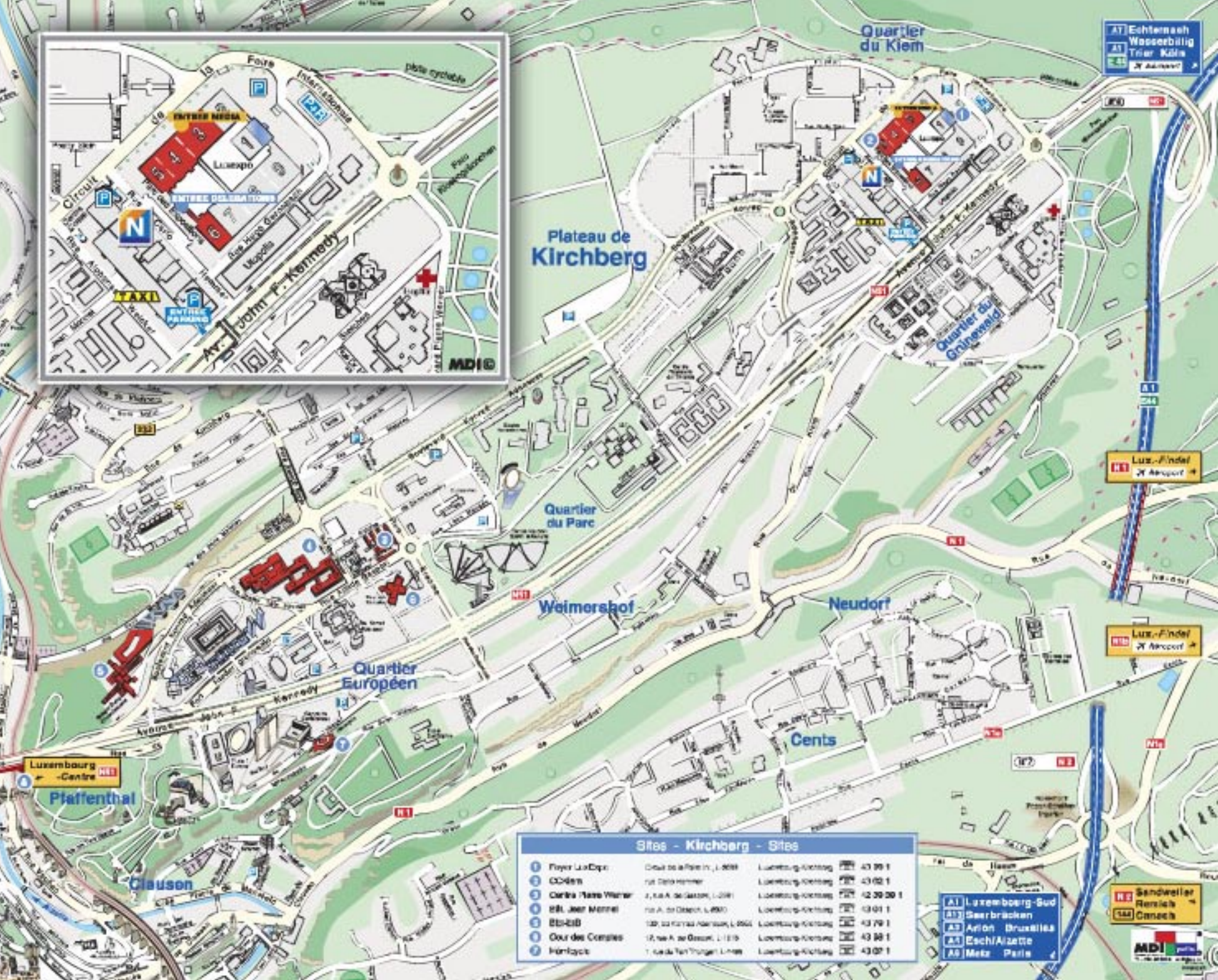

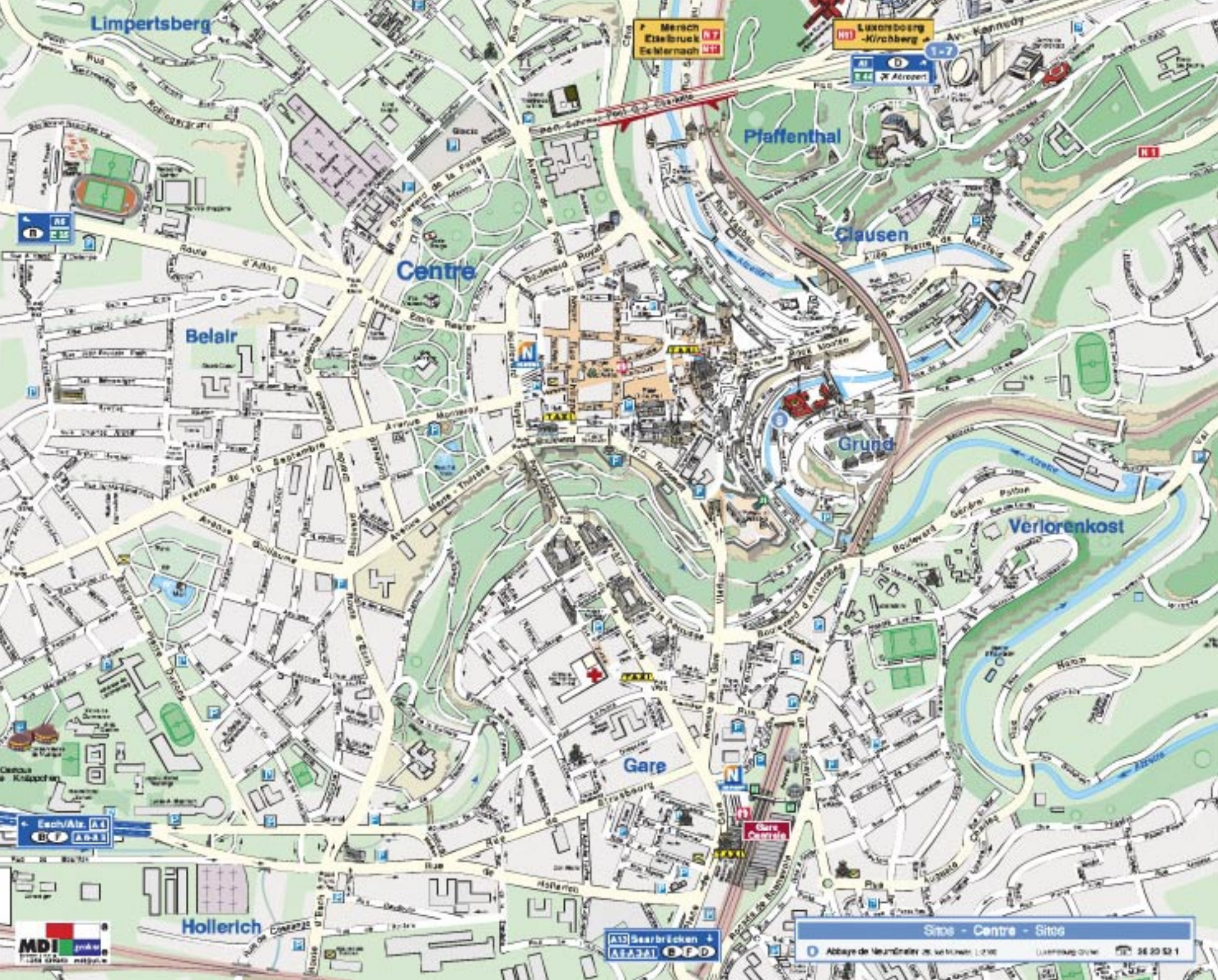

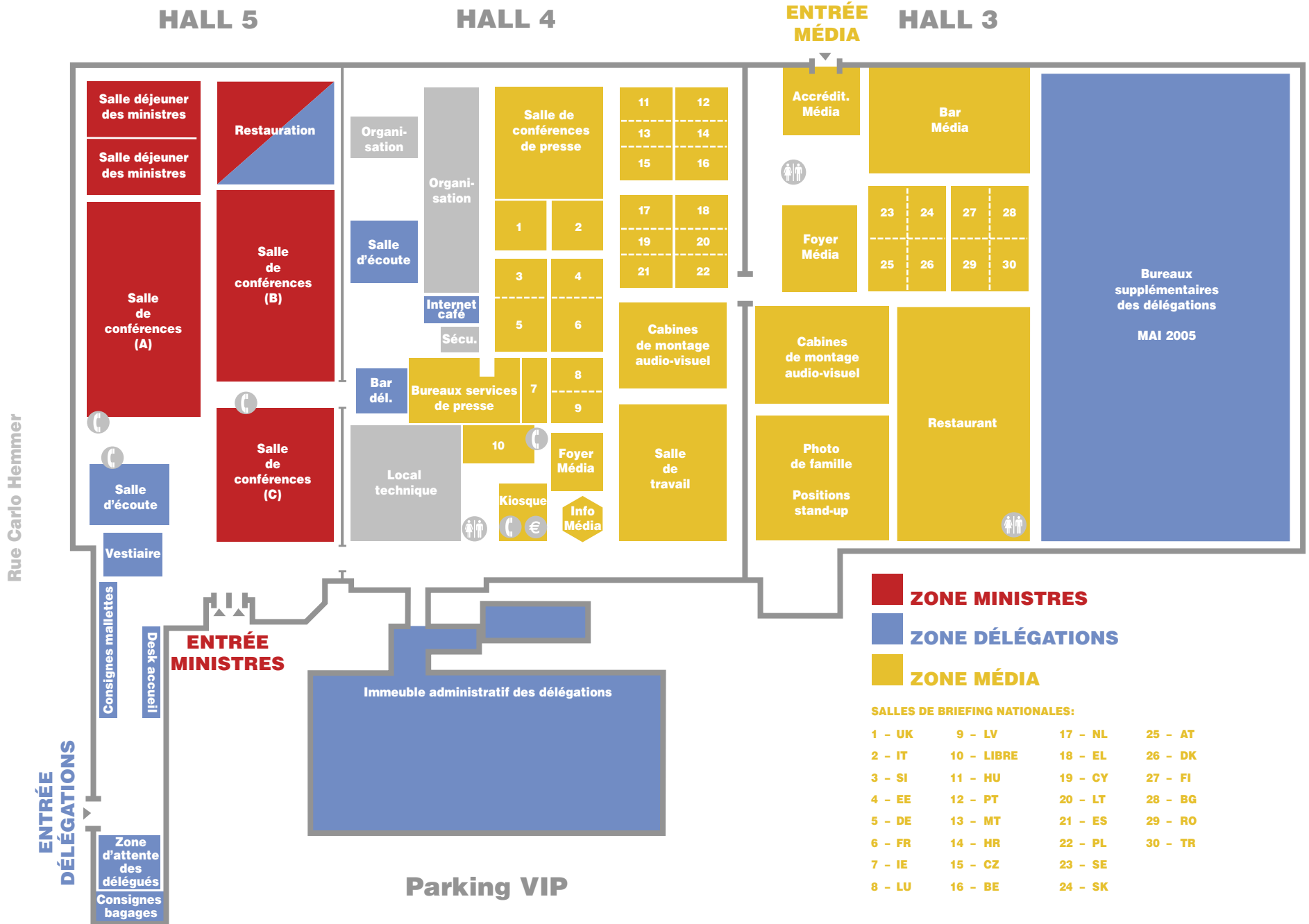
